Following is a list of things children could do in order to respond to any of the Bible stories or lessons:

- Draw or paint a picture of one of the following: favourite scene, most dramatic scene, one page divided into 3 parts for beginning, middle and end of story.
- Act out the story. Find costumes if possible.
- Make figures of characters in the story from plasticine or playdoh. Use the figures to act out the story.
- Draw a picture of the main character in the middle of the page. Around the drawing, write word to describe the character (brave, adventurous, wise, etc.)
- Cut pictures from a magazine or flyer that have something to do with the story or a character. Make a "story collage" with them.
- Make up a song, or a dance, or both, about the story or about the lesson that goes with the story. Perform it for a grownup. Take a video of your performance. Share the video with others.
- Convert the story to a puppet show, Make the puppets and act out the story. Film yourself acting out the story. Share the video with others.
