A Clock with No Hands
Theme: God is with us now.
Hello, Immanuel friends!
It is exciting to think about some of you who went back to school last week. If we were meeting in person, Ha Na would like to ask you about your new teachers and your classes.
Our first activity this week is "Things in Backpacks."
Answer the following questions. If you need to, have a grown-up help you write in the answers.

How big is it? What could you compare it to that is about the same size?
How old is it?
What do you like about it?
Is there anything you don't like about it?

Here is the story for today. You can read it yourself or get a grown-up to read it for you:

A friend of Ha Na's told her this story about her backpack. In her backpack she kept . . . a clock! This is a common tool that we use many times a day. But this person's clock was a little different. The clock was missing its hands. You know, those are the long and short pieces that point to the numbers to show us the time. Ha Na asked her friend, "What good is a clock that doesn't tell time?" Her friend replied, "But it does. My clock tells me that that the time is . . . now." In our Bible stories, God knows that the time is always . . . now. And now is when God is with us. Ha Na's friend's not-so-ordinary, not-so-useful clock that she keeps in her backpack is actually a very special tool. Whenever she hears someone ask "What time is it?" she smiles and knows that it is always "now."

As we go forth and live in the "nows" of the new school year, let us have faith and prepare with hope. God is with us now and God will still be with us now.

Older children could take time to write down a reflection about the new school year. They could answer questions such as:


What are my hopes for the school year?

Grab hold of your backpack or pencil case, and pray with a grown-up, as we faithfully prepare for this new school year.


