OPENING STATEMENT:

When Paul invited me to lead worship on this Sunday, he asked if I was aware of the tradition of the Sunday after Easter being designated Holy Humour Sunday...because apparently some members of this faith community are familiar with the tradition. I told him that I was familiar with Holy Humour Sunday. The tradition goes back to the early centuries of Christianity when the week after Easter was designated as 'days of joy and laughter' in some predominantly Christian countries. People hosted picnics and parties to celebrate the resurrection of Jesus. The Sunday after Easter was known as "Bright Sunday', In 1988, a group known as the Fellowship of Merry Christians, encouraged churches to rebirth 'Bright Sunday' as Holy Humour Sunday, with the theme "Jesus is the life of the party." So, today, let us worship with perhaps more of a smile on our faces than usual!
